

## Passover Seder at Glance and the Shortest Haggadah in the World)

(light candles)

1) Kiddush (*the first cup*)

2) Wash hands.

3) Eat greens.

4) **Maggid**

a) Break the middle Matzah (hide the afikoman).

b) **Maggid I:** Tell the Story – From the G'nut le-Shevach - Degradation to Praise-worthiness.

c) Two versions of g'nut le-shevach

(1) Four questions -- why is this night different?

(a) We were slaves and now we are free

(2) Four Sons – what does all this mean?

(a) Answer Two: we were idol worshippers, now we worship One God

d) **Maggid II:** Give an interpretation of Deuteronomy 26:5-19

e) **Maggid III:** Tell of the Three

Main symbols:

i) Pesach

ii) Matzah

iii) Maror

f) **Maggid IV:** See yourself as having personally come out of Egypt.

g) **End of Maggid:** Thank God for helping get us out.

h) Drink *second cup of wine*.

5) **Meal:**

a) Say the blessing over the “bread”.

b) Say the blessing over Matzah.

c) Eat the Matzah.

d) Say a blessing and eat bitter herbs.

e) Eat the sandwich of matzah, bitter herbs and charoset

f) Eat the meal.

6) **After Meal – epikoman**

a) Find the afikoman and eat from all three matzahs.

b) Birkat HaMazon - Thank God for the food – *drink third cup*.

c) Sing songs of redemption

d) *drink fourth cup*.

e) Pour a fifth cup, but don't drink it – or do.

f) More Songs.

g) Announce the Seder is over – next year in Jerusalem.

(sing more songs)

### The Shortest Haggada in the World

1. Light Candles, say Kiddush (drink a cup)

2. Tell the Story

a. two versions - Degradation to Praiseworthiness version one and two (see above)

b. then drash a text or just tell the story

c. Explain the Symbols

d. Think of yourself as having personally come out of Egypt.

e. Thank God (drink another cup)

3. Eat the meal

4. Thank God (drink another cup)

5. Sing songs of salvation

6. (Drink another cup)

7. Seder's done; next year in J-lem, sing more songs.
